SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

EXAMS DURING CLASS TIME

There are many exams held in May and June that occur DURING SCHEDULED CLASS TIME. Teachers will be informing their students of exactly when they will be held. There are also Secondary 5 English and French exams in May and June. These are ministerial exams and are indicated on the Secondary 5 exam schedule.

SCHOOL ACCESS DURING EXAM PERIOD

Students have access to the school if they are writing an exam or are attending tutorials. Students who are waiting for an exam or a tutorial must do so in the cafeteria only, which will be used as a quiet space for studying. Loitering or hanging out in any other area of the school will not be permitted.

SIGN-OUTS DURING EXAM PERIOD

Any student in secondary 1 or 2 who wishes to leave after their exam and NOT remain for tutorials MUST have parental authorization. This can be done by parents through the Mozaik portal, or by calling the school. Students will be required to sign out at the front office before they leave.

DROP-IN TUTORIALS

Tutorials are offered for students wishing to have a space to study with access to their teacher for questions. These are “drop-in” tutorials, meaning the students' attendance is voluntary, however, if students remain in the building after their morning exams, they are expected to attend a tutorial.

ABSENCES

All students and parents are reminded of the importance of being present for exams whether they are written in class or during the examination period. ANY ABSENCE FROM EXAMS MUST BE 'JUSTIFIED' BY A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE, COURT SUMMONS OR DEATH IN THE FAMILY. As outlined in the Student Agenda, parents are requested not to schedule vacation time during the exam period as these exams cannot be rescheduled.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The regular Code of Conduct applies during the exam period. Secondary 1 and 2 students are NOT permitted to leave school grounds during the exam period.

CAFETERIA

The cafeteria will serve lunch up until and including June 9th. The cafeteria service area will be closed as of June 10th.

LATE TO AN EXAM

Students who are more than 30 minutes late may not enter the examination room without an administrator's approval. **Please note that for Ministerial exams, entry after 30 minutes is prohibited under ANY circumstance.** Also note that if the late arrival is later than the halfway mark of the exam (non-ministerial), the student will not be permitted to write the exam.

BATHROOM BREAKS

Students may not leave the exam room for the first hour of the exam, unless it's an emergency, and then only when accompanied by a supervisor. All bathroom breaks will require that the student be escorted to the bathroom.

BUS SCHEDULE DURING EXAMS

During exam time the bus schedule will remain the same as it has all year round. Buses will be available up to and including June 19, as per the regular schedule.

ELECTRONICS

All electronics (cell phones, Apple watches, air pods) have to be left in the student's locker. Any student found with these electronic devices in their possession during the exam will have their exam confiscated and given the grade of zero.
